Kentucky Lake

Kentucky Lake is a magnet for vacationers and fishermen from a wide area of mid-America, with recreation use amounting to some 17 million visits each year. Along its nearly 250 Square miles, just over 160,000 acres of cove-studded shoreline are many boat docks and resorts, 4 state parks, the Tennessee National Wildlife refuge,



48 public access areas, 2 county parks, 5 municipal parks, 2 state wildlife management areas, 10 group camps and clubs, 92 commercial recreation areas. and 3 small wildlife areas. Welcome to the Largest manmade lake in the Eastern United States just between the Great Lakes & the Gulf of Mexico! This lake stretches from Gilbertsville. KY down to Pickwick Dam on the Tennessee, Alabama border.

Land Between The Lakes

Land Between The Lakes National Recreation Area (LBL) is a 170,000-acre outdoorsmen's paradise between Kentucky Lake and Lake Barkley in western Kentucky and Tennessee.

This natural playground not only features vast forests, open lands and streams. Adventurers will also discover attractions, camping, trails, wildlife and historical exhibits and much more. Families enjoy the diverse educational and recreational facilities such as the Woodlands Nature Station and the Homeplace 1850s Farm.

Kentucky Lake and Lake Barkley are on each side of Land Between The Lakes, featuring more than 340 square miles of water for fishing, boating and recreation. Dozens of boat ramps dot each side of the lakes. Pontoons, fishing boats, house boats, jet skis, water toys and other rentals are available for anyone who wants to spend time on the lake.

Several resorts and other accommodation are located just across the water from LBL.

Over 200 restaurants are within a short drive of LBL as well as a great selection of attractions the entire family can enjoy.

PARIS LANDING STATE PARK AND MARINA



The park sits on the widest part of the lake making it the perfect location for all water sports such as fishing, boating, and waterskiing. The park also offers a beautiful and challenging par 72, 18-hole golf course. The park pro shop provides golfing supplies, lessons, rental clubs, and carts.

Located at mile marker 66.1, along the west bank of the beautiful Tennessee River, Paris Landing State Park Marina has been an oasis for boaters for more than 50 years. In addition to hosting a spectacular view of Kentucky Lake, Paris Landing Marina has overnight dockage (transient docking) available for boats up to 300 ft in length. Jet ski lifts, tie-up slips, and uncovered and covered slips are available at monthly or yearly rates. Certain slips come equipped with water, cable, and various electrical services depending on the size. We have a shower available as well as Wi-Fi for transients.

The marina sells non-ethanol gas, and diesel fuel has a pump-out service and offers free transportation to the golf course. We also have fishing bait, ice, beer, and general supplies. A three-lane boat ramp is available for no fee.

The Lodge at Paris Landing sits on the shores of Kentucky Lake offering 91 state-of-the-art guest rooms. Offering multiple room types, including a variety of suites, guests can enjoy the outdoors and all the comforts of home. The lodge is also home to a restaurant and full-service lounge. The restaurant offers fresh meals and craft cocktails with indoor and outdoor seating. Lodge guests have access to an outdoor pool, fire pits, and living spaces. Each lodge room offers a private balcony with views of Kentucky Lake.

EIFFEL TOWER PARK

Eiffel Tower Park welcomes visitors with its 66'-foot, lighted Eiffel Tower. The park offers recreational opportunities, as well as lovely trails, a playground, picnicking, sports venues and more. Visitors can even take a photo with the Eiffel Tower from the "selfie platform."

Eiffel Tower Park Extended (across the street) offers unpaved trails, plus a pond where folks with a valid fishing license and trout stamp may fish for free. To use Eiffel Tower Park Extended, park by the tower and make the short walk across Volunteer Drive.

Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) stocks this pond with 1,000 trout in winter

HENRY COUNTY FARMERS MARKET

HERITAGE CENTER - CAVITT PLACE

Cavitt Place, at 614 North Poplar Street, in the historical Poplar Street neighborhood is a must see when you visit the area. The mansion has been eloquently spoken of as "the Jewel of West Tennessee." Cavitt Place is home to the Paris-Henry County Heritage Center. We serve as a local museum and cultural center. We create special events for our audience, and we offer the mansion to the community for their special occasions.

The Italian Renaissance house was built in 1916 by Colonel O.C.Barton, a prominent business man and philanthropist, to enjoy with his wife Tillie, and their family. The mansion, since serving as a residence, has served well and long in the community. The house provided army office headquarters during WWII, and served for many years as the county health department before becoming the Heritage Center.

SURROUNDING AREAS

FORT DONELSON NATIONAL BATTLEFIELD

Fort Donelson National Battlefield preserves Fort
Donelson and Fort Heiman, two sites of the American Civil
War Forts Henry and Donelson Campaign, in which Union
Army Brigadier General Ulysses S. Grant and Flag
Officer Andrew Hull Foote captured three Confederate forts
and opened two rivers, the Tennessee River and
the Cumberland River, to control by the Union Navy.

CROSS CREEK NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGEE

Cross Creeks National Wildlife Refuge is a part of the U.S. system of National Wildlife Refuges located along the Lake Barkley impoundment of the Cumberland River **Visit Us** If you enjoy going outdoors, consider a visit to Cross Creeks National Wildlife Refuge! From hunting and fishing to wildlife watching, kayaking and photography.

PARIS LANDING GOLF COURSE

The Paris Landing State Park Golf Course is situated on the western shore of Kentucky Lake. The entire course is tree-lined, creating a feeling that you are the only one on the course, very rarely seeing another foursome. Several holes skirt Kentucky Lake, producing a natural balance of rolling land, trees, and water. Hole #12 is a 586-yard, par 5 with an elevated green overlooking Kentucky Lake and hole #4 is a downhill 186-yard par 3 with the water providing a scenic backdrop. The Paris Landing Golf Course is a great destination for year-round play. In 2017 the greens were recontoured with the addition of Champion Bermuda which has been a great addition to an already good golf course.

LAND BETWEEN THE LAKES

Land Between The Lakes is a National Recreation Area that is controlled by the US Forest Service. This 170,000-acre, uninhabited area is a great place for anyone to spend a couple of days or more. Numerous attractions within the park include the Nature Station, Elk & Bison Prairie, Golden Pond Planetarium, Homeplace 1850s, and Turkey Bay OHV Area.











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
